PLEASE DO NOT JAYWALK, USE THE DESIGNATED CROSSWALKS ON TUSTIN AVENUE.

TO APPROACH FROM JAMBOREE ROAD

Traveling North on Pacific Coast Hwy, drive approximately 2 miles. At the stoplight for Tustin Ave, turn right. Take the first right on Avon Street, and follow this road to the large metered public parking lot.

TO APPROACH FROM NEWPORT BOULEVARD (ROUTE 55)

Traveling West on Newport Blvd, just after the stoplight for Hospital Road, take the right-hand exit for Highway 1. At the bottom of the hill, make a left at the light for Pacific Coast Hwy. At the stoplight for Tustin Ave, turn left. Take the first right on Avon Street, and follow this road to the large metered Public Parking Lot.

Although it is possible to use Newport Blvd to the Pacific Coast Hwy, alternate routes are highly recommended, especially in December.

From the San Diego (405), Santa Ana (5), or Corona Del Mar (73) Freeways:

Take the Costa Mesa (55) Freeway south towards Newport Beach. The Freeway ends and merges into Newport Blvd. Stay on Newport Blvd. Southbound for two miles. Once you pass Hospital Road (at Hoag Hospital), move into the far right lane. This lane exits to Coast Highway (Hwy 1). Do not continue straight on the bridge, which crosses over Coast Highway towards Balboa. Turn left on Coast Highway, south towards San Diego. Pass thru two stop lights at Riverside and Tustin. Turn right into Hornblower Cruises & Events. If you get to the "Duffy" sign, you have gone too far.

From Jamboree:

Take Jamboree to East Coast Highway and turn right. Drive approximately 2 miles. Look for the Holiday Inn Express on the right side. Turn left into Hornblower Cruises & Events. If you get to the stoplight at Tustin, you have gone about 100 yards too far.
